The answer is 4.

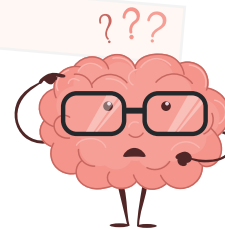
What was my number?

How many people are on the bus now?

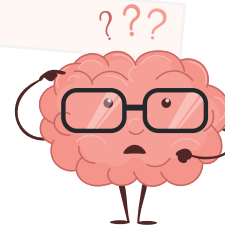


Real-life Maths
