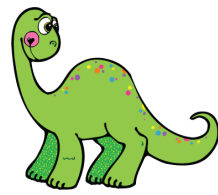




Past Tense



The simplest way to make the past tense is by adding <ed> to the verb.

Today I talk

talk + ed

Yesterday I talked

If a verb already ends with an <e>, cross it off and then add <ed>.

Today I smile

smile + ed

Yesterday I smiled
