Home Learning

Phonic Home Learning

Every Friday, your child will bring home their phonics book. Inside, there will be a list of words containing the sound they are learning that week.

Please support your child in learning to read and spell these words at home. The phonics book should be returned to school by Thursday so that it can be updated with the new sounds and words for the following week.

Home Reading

Home reading books will be sent home every Friday. Please read with your child regularly and record any comments in their reading record book. Your child's reading book and reading record should be brought into school every day so that they have regular opportunities to read with an adult throughout the week.

Keywords

High-frequency and tricky words will be sent home with your child's reading book. Please practise these words regularly with your child to help them recognise and read them confidently.

Maths

Each week, your child will bring home a 'Big Maths CLIC sheet'. The number problems will be linked to the mathematical skills and concepts they have been learning in school that week. A 'Big Maths Learn Its' test sheet will also be sent home to support your child in practising and developing their recall of key number facts. **These sheets are for home practice and do not need to be returned to school.**
