Home Learning

Phonics

Every **Friday** phonic books will be sent home. They will include the sound of the week we are learning in class along with a list of words that have that sound. In addition to this they will have some 'tricky' words that are not phonetic. Please encourage your child to read these words by segmenting (sounding out) and blending. Ask your children to write the words and complete fun games with them such as guess the word or muddling the letters up and asking them to rearrange them again.

Big Maths

Each week pupils will complete two Big Maths assessments. Beat That and Clic will be completed on a Friday. Pupils should aim to increase their score by one each week. Pupils will bring home their completed sheets on a Monday so they can complete any corrections. Daily Big Math sessions will be taught for around 20 minutes alongside our main math scheme of work.
