PPS Eisteddfod Results

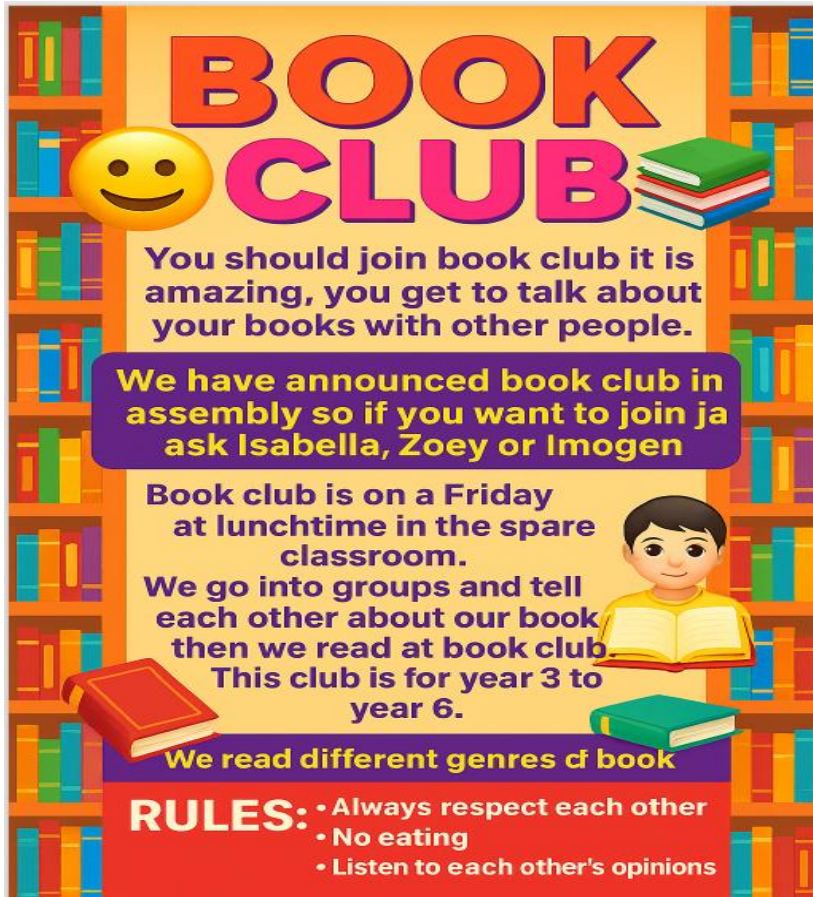
Last Week's Eisteddfod was an incredible celebration. We had so many amazing entries, and we are so proud of all the effort everyone put in!
