Jenson – I walk into lampposts.

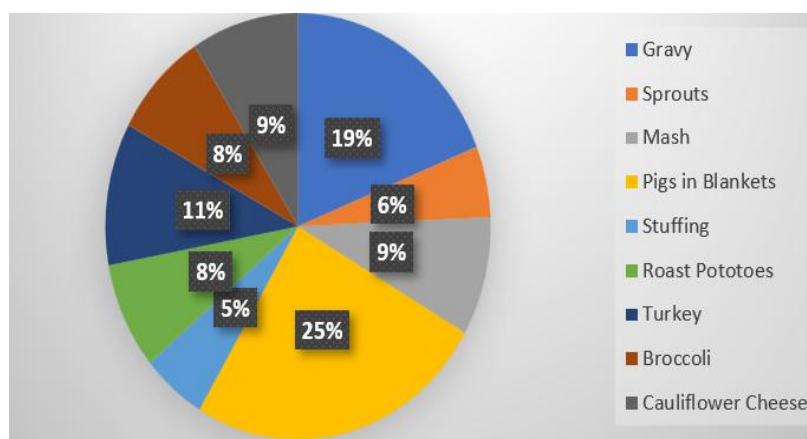
Max – I like interacting with nature and going to the zoo.
