National Test Data

The latest National Test Scores for all pupils from year 2 to year 6 are now available. Pupils have taken three National Tests in Reading, Numeracy Procedural and Numeracy Reasoning. To access the scores, you will need to log into the pupils Hwb account and click on the Personalised Assessments icon with the blue tick. There is a tab to click which has pupil progress and pupil feedback. There is also a parent/ carer guide to explain what the test results mean. Pupils will know how to log in. If you need any help with logging in please speak to a member of staff who can help you.
