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Sun Safety Advice (in case the warm weather persists!)

During the hot weather children are advised by NHS Wales to wear:

- plenty of sunscreen (at least SPF30/ 4 star UVA protection)
- a wide brimmed hat to shade neck, face and ears
- a long sleeved top
- trousers or long skirts/ dresses
- sunglasses with wrap around lenses BSM 12312-1:2013E

Parents and carers should apply Sunscreen (Factor 30+) on their children before school each morning and are encouraged to provide their children with sunscreen (Factor 30+) for use during the day. Younger children may be assisted with the application of their sunscreen if they cannot do it for themselves.

The sunscreen must be clearly labelled with name and class. It will be stored in crates and kept by the class teacher. The crates of sunscreen will be made available to the children just before lunch time.
