Children will come to school dressed in a white t-shirt, old shorts and old sports shoes. Children will need sunglasses to protect their eyes.

The day will be a normal school day with normal routines.

In the afternoon when it's time to run, the teacher will take pupils outside to the running track.

Children will run one lap around a circuit. While they are running, teachers at the stations will throw coloured chalk powder and the chalk will land on the children. Children will be bright and colourful at the end of the run.

Children can run, skip, walk or jog. There are no winners or race times, it's all about having fun!

If children do not want colour on them, they can wear a coloured shirt so teachers and helpers know not to throw colour - OR - If they do not want colour on them, children can take part in the Relaxed Run where no colour will be thrown.

If they just want to watch the Run, that's fine too!

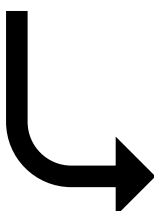
After the Rainbow Run children will move back to classrooms to collect belongings and get ready to go home.
