Holidays in Term Time

Please avoid taking your child on holiday in term time. Term time holidays create gaps in learning.

The Education (pupil Registration)(Wales) Regulations 2010 give schools discretionary power to grant leave for the purpose of an annual family holiday during term time. Parents do not have an automatic right to withdraw pupils from school for a holiday and, in law, must apply for permission in advance.

In considering whether holiday requests are authorised or unauthorised we will take into consideration your child's current attendance and previous year's attendance. In line with the Welsh Government Callio Campaign, attendance below 96% (for any reason) will not be authorised.

Attending school gives children the best chance of success.
