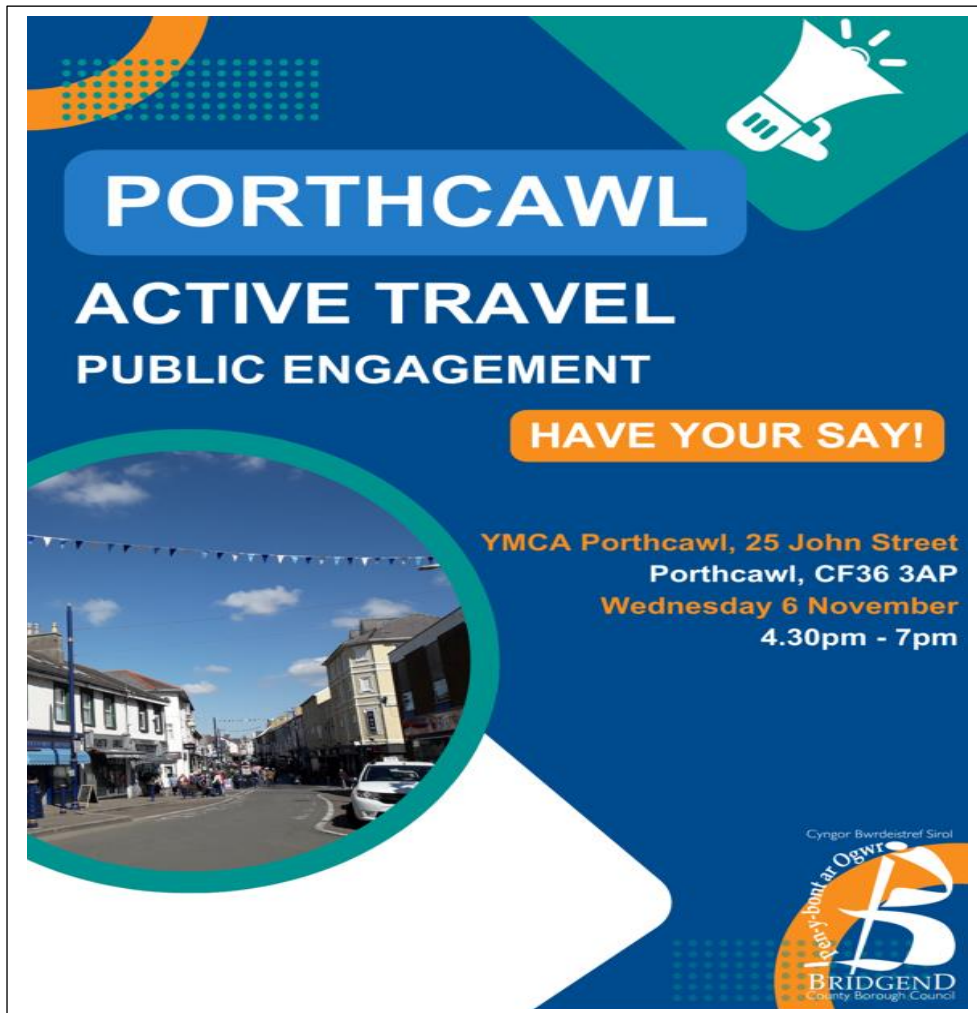
CHILDREN IN NEED
