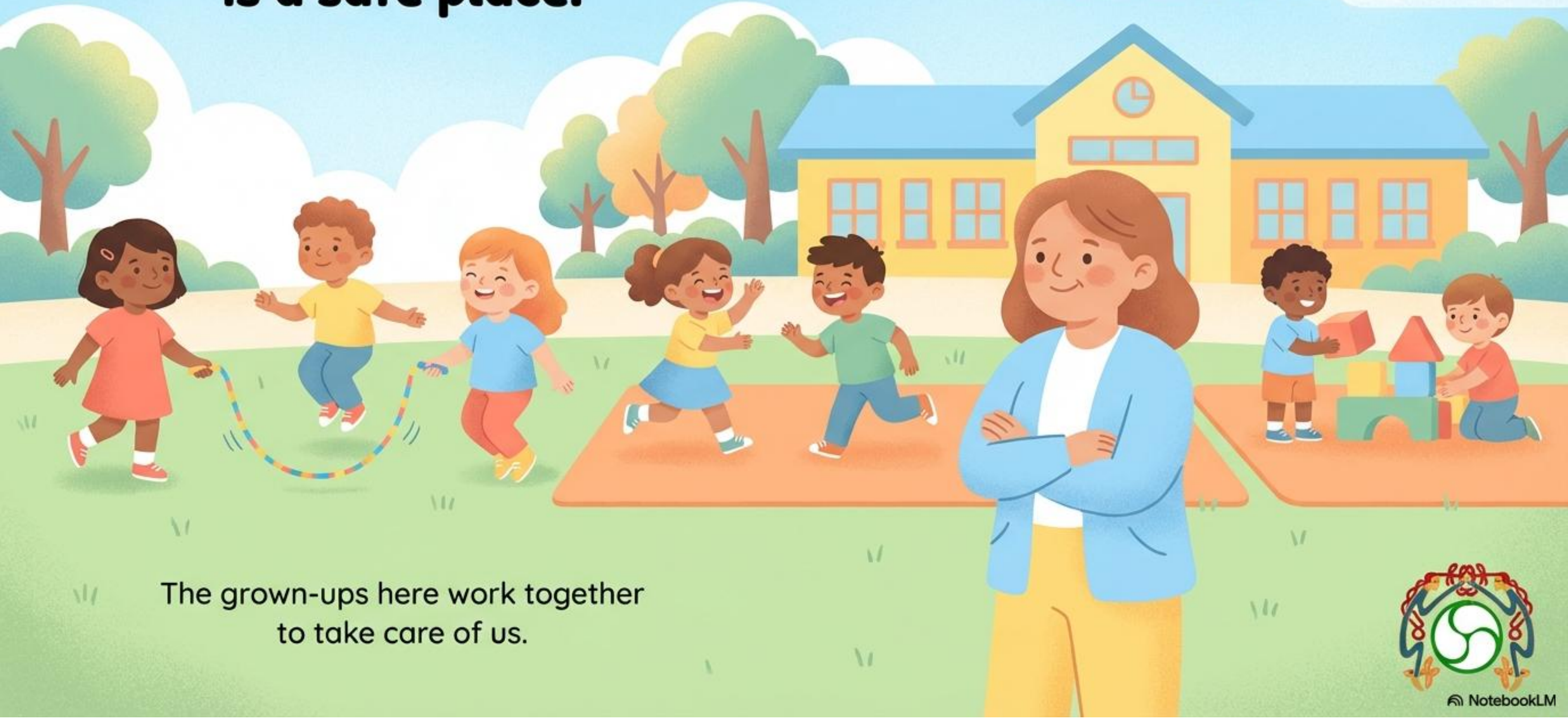


Lockdown at Porthcawl Primary School

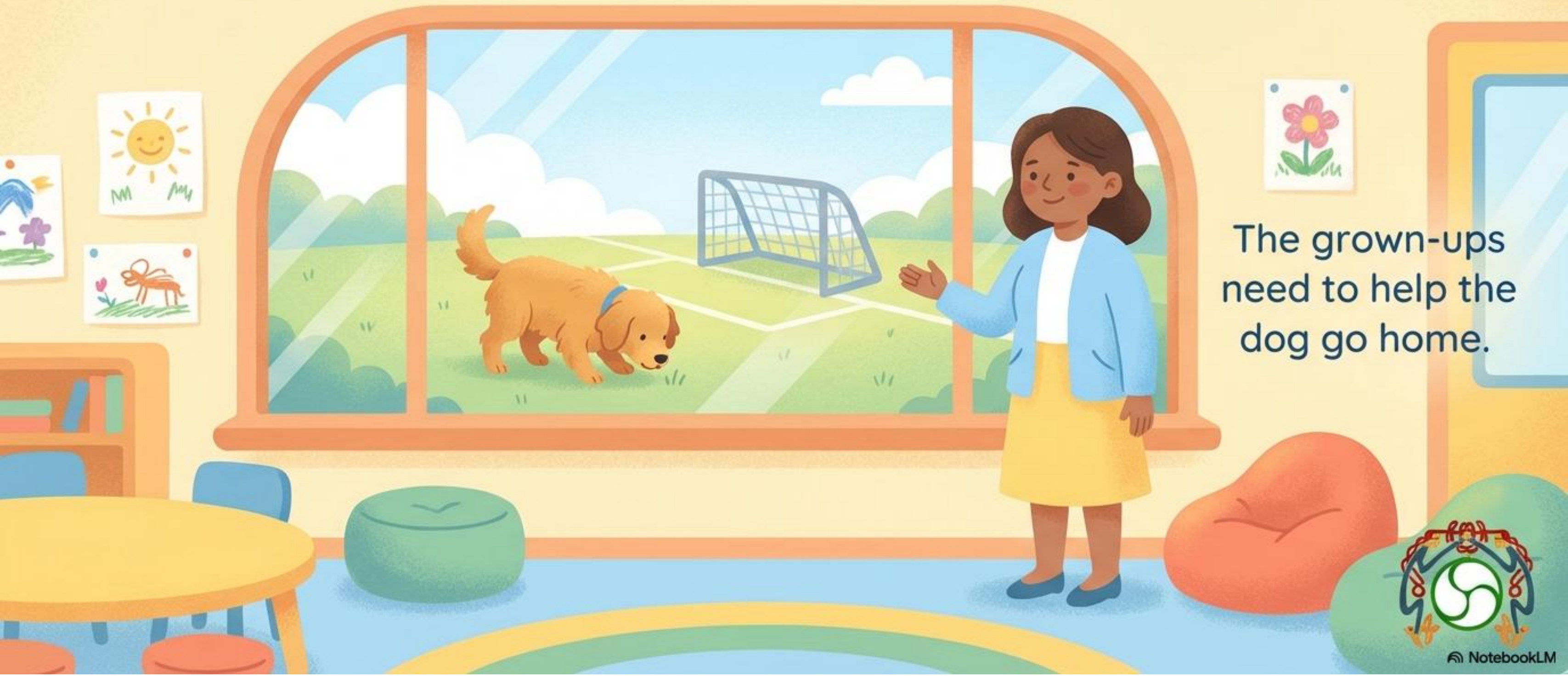


**Sometimes, a visitor might

Look at your trusted adult – they are calm because they know exactly what to do.

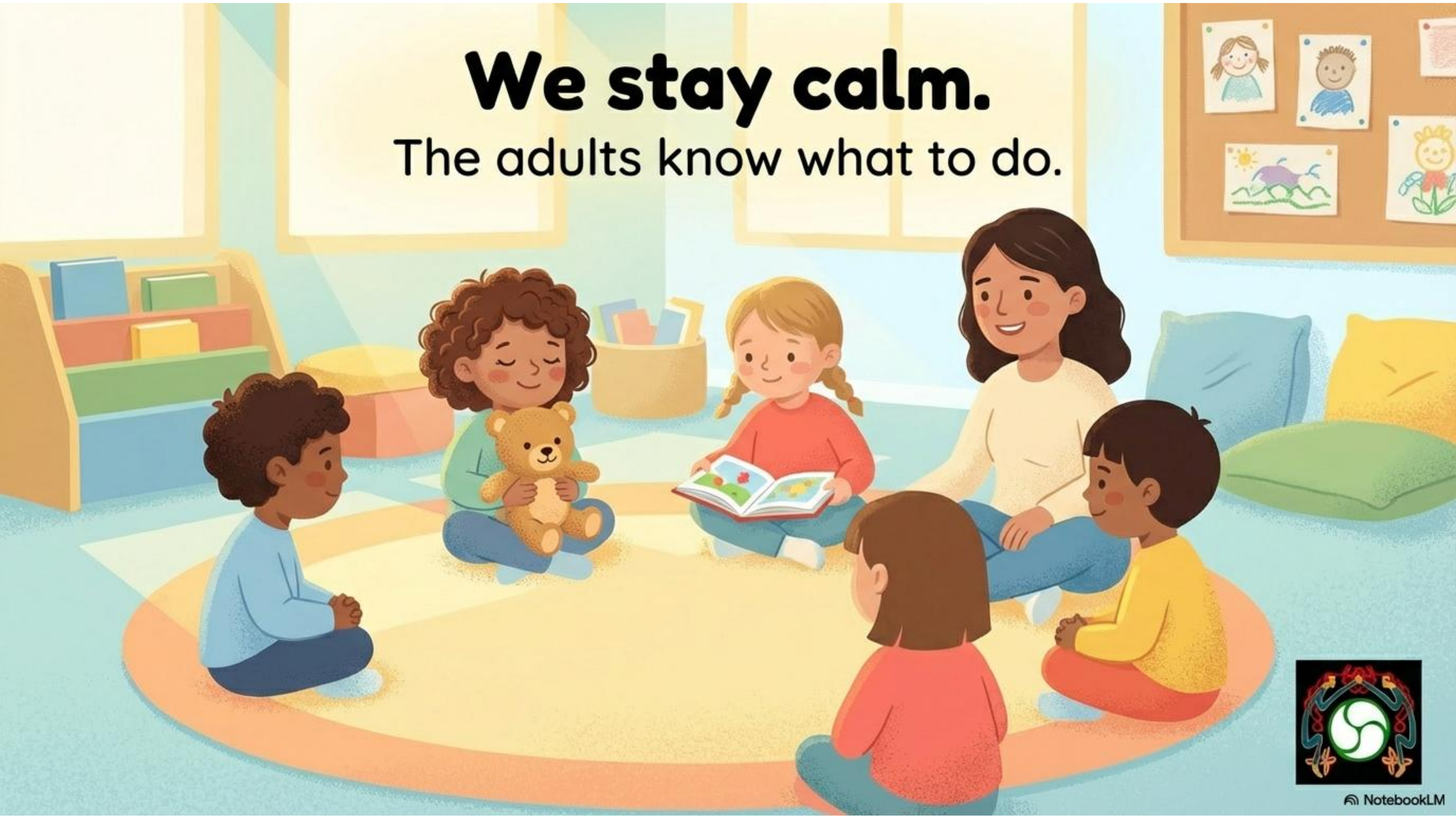


We use quiet bodies and quiet voices.

The adults know what to do.

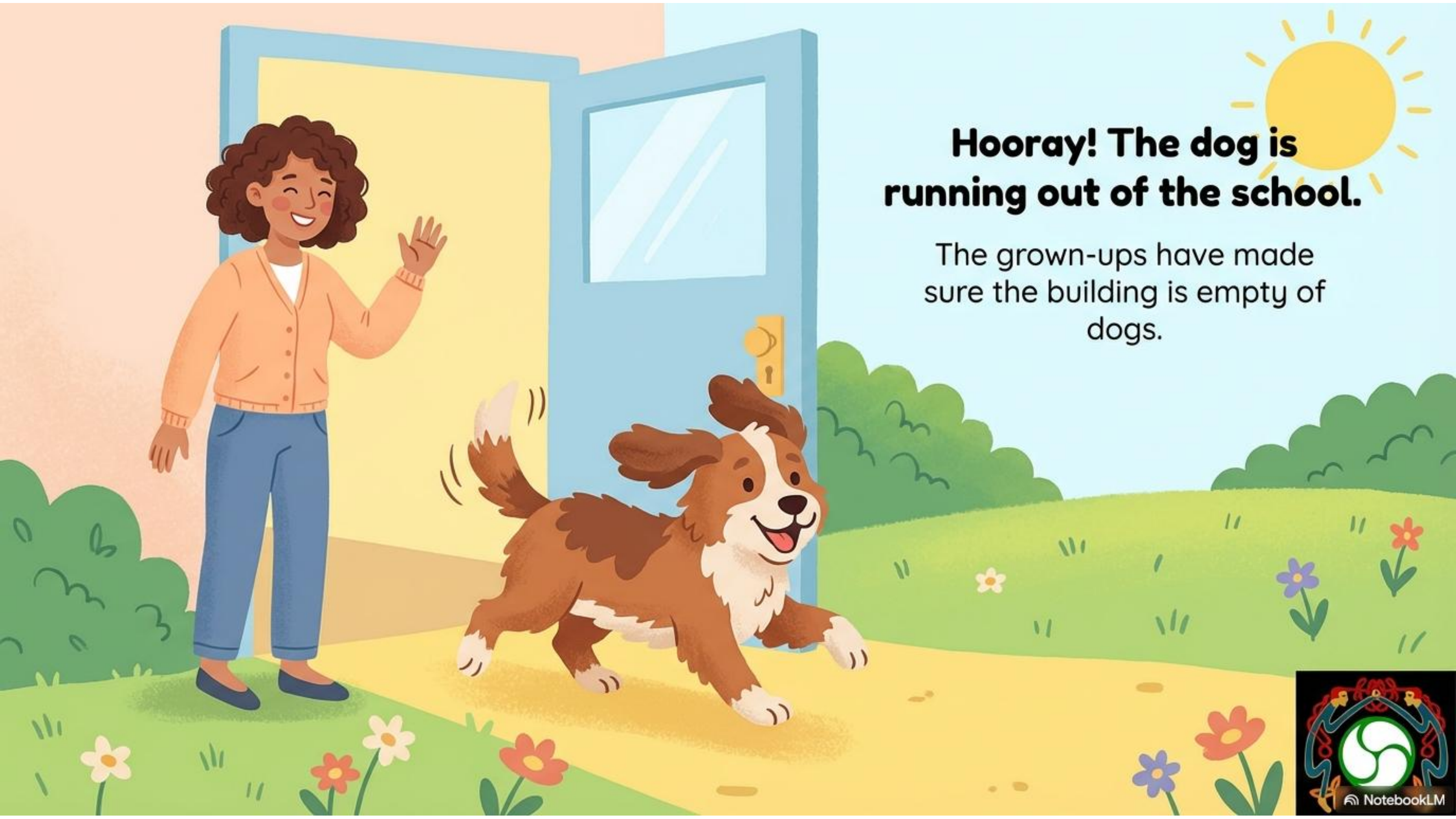


During Quiet Safety Time at Porthcawl Primary School, remember:

We are just staying safe.**

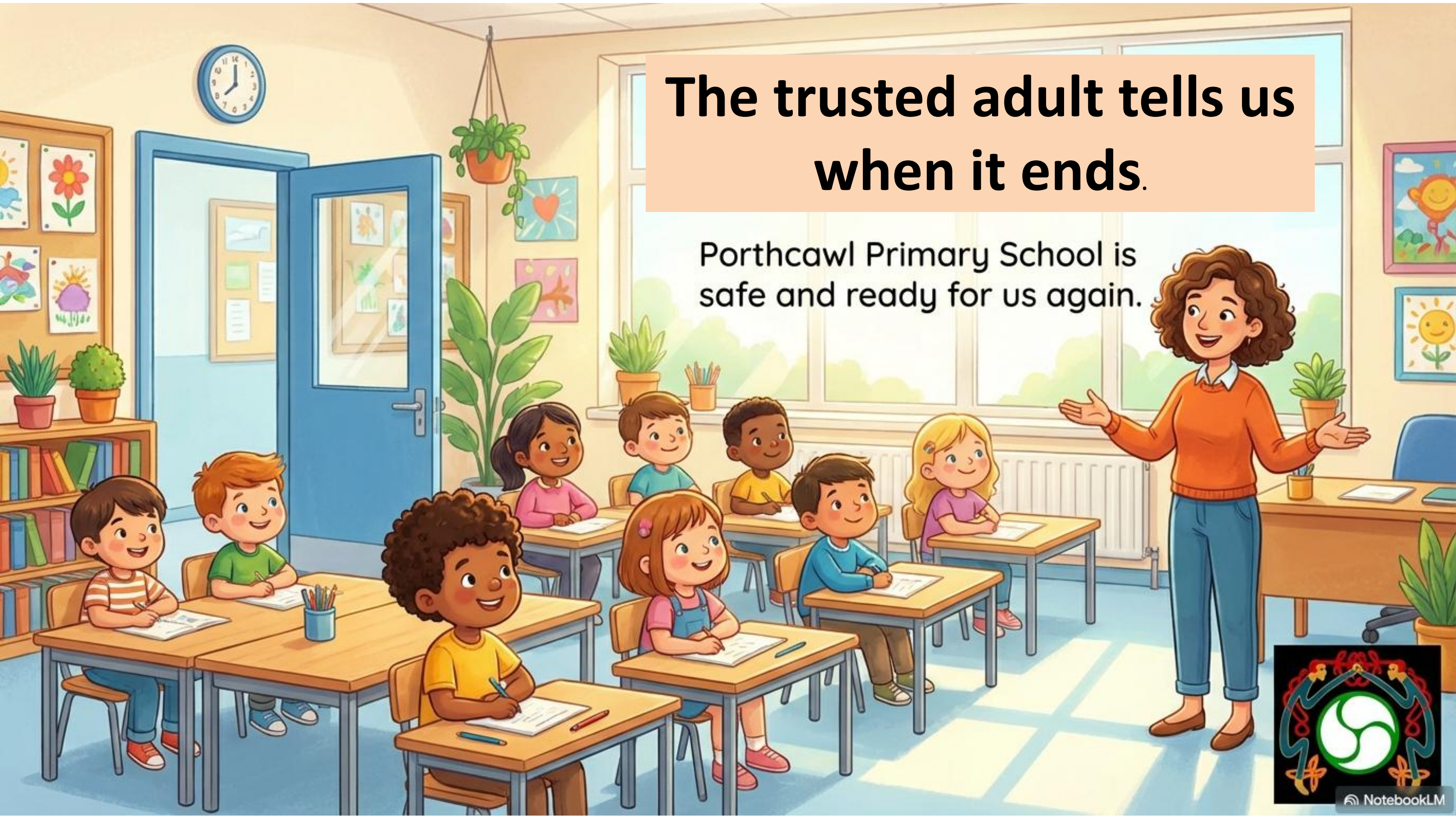




**Hooray! The dog is
