In English we will be using the following texts this term-

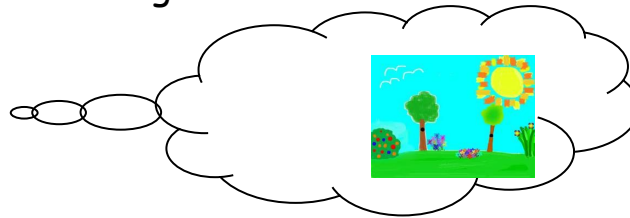
The Spider and the Fly by Tony Diterlizzi

Spellings
