In Maths we will be completing a wide range of activities using Big Maths:

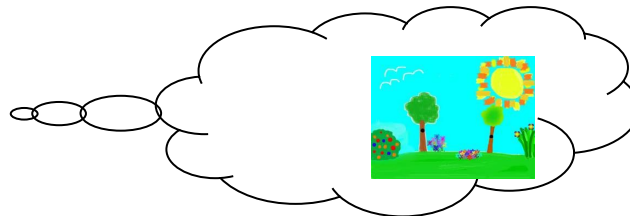
Place value to 3 digit numbers
